Interactive Video Instructions:

We have recently changed the way the FLV file in your PNP membership operates. You no longer have to place a link outside of your video, we have set it up so that your users can click a special learn more button embedded right in your PNP video screen.

The purpose of this guide is to show you how to place your own link inside the learn more button.

Quick Start For Advanced Users:

1. Right-click on the **filename00000config.xml** file and open it up inside your favorite text editor.
2. Scroll down near the bottom of the xml file to about line 183 to the URL **<http://plugnplayvideos.com>** and replace it with your own custom link.
3. Click Save.
4. Copy and paste the video embed code from the **filename.00000.html** file into the web page that you want your video to appear.
5. Upload all the files in the folder to your server...
(except **filename.00000.html**)
Make sure to keep the file structure in place.
6. Type the url to your page in your web browser to play the video and test your learn more button.

General Instructions For All Users:

After unzipping the FLV video folder, you should find the following files:

- license.pdf
 - swfobject.js
 - filename00000.flv
 - filename00000.html
 - filename00000.js
 - filename00000_config.xml
 - filename_controller.swf
1. Right-click on the **filename00000config.xml** file and open it up inside your favorite text editor. (notepad, frontpage, dreamweaver, etc...)
 2. Scroll down near the bottom of the xml file until you find the following tags `<url>http://pluginplayvideos.com`
 3. Simply replace **http://pluginplayvideos.com** with your own link.
For example **http://yourlinkhere.com**
This is the link your visitors will be directed to when they click the learn more button on your FLV video.
 4. Now let's embed the video code into the web page that you want your video to appear on...
 5. Open up the **filename00000.html** file inside your favorite html editor. (notepad, frontpage, dreamweaver, etc...)

You can embed the video into your web page a couple of different ways...

THE FIRST WAY (recommended for advanced users only)

1. Copy & paste everything between the `<header>` `</header>` tags from the `filename00000.html` file in between the header tags of the page you want your video to appear on.
2. Copy & paste everything you see between the `<body id="cs_flashBody" >` `</body>` tags and replace them with the body tags on your web page.

This method requires that you upload all the files inside your FLV folder to your web server... (except `filename.00000.html`)

If you decide to go this route, you need to make sure all of the following files below are uploaded to your web server.

You can upload the files to the root of your web server or place them inside a sub folder, Just make sure that all the PNP files are located inside the same folder with your video page.

3. After you have placed the video codes in your web page, upload all of the following files to your web server.
 - `swfobject.js`
 - `filename00000.flv`
 - `yourwebpage.html` (.htm, .php, etc...)
 - `filename00000.js`
 - `filename00000_config.xml`
 - `filename_controller.swf`
4. Type the url to your page in your web browser to play the video and test your learn more button.

SUB FOLDER EXAMPLE:

<http://www.yoursite.com/subfolder/yourwebpage.html>

THE SECOND WAY (recommended for everyone)

1. Copy & paste everything between the last video code in your `filename00000.html` file between the `<div id="media"></div>` tags into the page where you want your video.

This method is much easier because it does not require you to place anything between your header tags and you don't need to upload all the files to your server for your video to work.

2. After you have placed the video codes in your web page, upload all of the following files to your web server.

You can upload your files to the root folder of your web server or place them inside a sub folder, just make sure that all the PNP files are in the same folder that you have your video page in.

- filename00000.flv
- yourwebpage.html (.htm, .php, etc...)
- filename00000_config.xml
- filename_controller.swf

4. Type the url to your page in your web browser to play the video and test your learn more button.
